## LOCATION

Grid reference SE208969. Richmond Equestrian Centre is situated only 5 miles from the A1 North and South. Take the slip road turning for Catterick, Richmond and Tunstall (A6136). Follow brown tourist signs for Richmond Equestrian Centre. Take the first right and then left again at the T-junction towards Tunstall. Before you enter Tunstall village take the first right turn after the 30mph sign. Richmond Equestrian Centre is 1 mile up this road on the left. Do NOT enter via Catterick Garrison there is a small very weak bridge. The final approach road is narrow. Please allocate extra time due to possible congestion.
